The Cross Tay Link Road and other Scone planning matters

Thank you for your letter of 27 November 2016 with all the information contained therein.

I note the Community Council's ongoing concern about the definition of the term "committed project". From my own reading of the Council's correspondence, I am still no clearer personally as to how exactly this is defined. However, I do note from the correspondence that the intention is that these matters will be clarified when the issue comes before the Council meeting in December which is to consider these matters.

It may be that this will resolve the issue, but I would certainly agree that clarification from Council officers as to where matters stand exactly with CTRL and the relationship with future housing developments would be helpful to all parties. Accordingly, I have written to the Council's Chief Executive to request a meeting with the Community Council, and I would be happy to attend and even act as Chair if that would be helpful.
