**Proposed Development – Scone North, Scone**  
**Planning Application 16/02127/IPM**

We have previously submitted objections/comments to the above planning application and now wish to submit an **additional** objection/comment.

The second stage of the DMRB process for the Cross Tay Link Road was completed by Perth & Kinross Council, prior to the submission date of this application.

The preparation of the DMRB Stage 2 Report requires the analysis of the scheme options identified at that time.

Each of these options requires to be developed to such an extent that dimensions of embankments, cuttings and principal structures can be given, and from that information estimated costs for each scheme option should be provided.

In addition all the scheme options require completion of a traffic assessment, an economic assessment and an environmental assessment.

Despite repeated requests, Perth & Kinross Council have failed to release copies of these Stage 2 Reports for the use of Community Councils and the general public.

We consider that, as the CTLR plays an integral part in the proposed development of H29, the CTLR Stage 2 Report should be available to allow the public to utilise its contents when commenting on the H29 proposals.
